Detail Itinerary

Day 06: Fly to Kathmandu and transfer to Nagarkot 6

Kathmandu

Pokhara

Pokhara is near the Annapurna mountains. It has a peaceful setting by Phewa Lake. This lakeside city is famous for its breathtaking views of Machhapuchhre (Fishtail) Mountain, mirrored in the lake’s clear waters. You can visit the World Peace Pagoda or explore Bindhyabasini Temple.

Bhaktapur

Bhaktapur showcases the best examples of Newari architecture. It features numerous temples and palaces, such as the iconic Nyatapola Temple and the historic 55-Window Palace. In Pottery Square, watch artisans create traditional pottery using age-old methods. Visit Dattatreya Temple to feel the spiritual atmosphere of this ancient city.
